


About

Damion Hahn

- Cornell Assistant Coach
- 2x NCAA Champion
- 4X AII-American
- Big Ten Male Athlete of the Year

Cornell assistant coach Damion Hahn has had a career that is nothing less than remarkable. Hahn became a 2x National Champion and 4x All-American during his collegiate career and has served on the coaching staff at Cornell for the past seven years. After his senior season at the University of Minnesota, Hahn earned the coveted Jesse Owens Male Athlete of the Year award, given to the top male athlete in the Big Ten. Hahn's individual success has had a direct impact on the success of the Cornell wrestling program. Since Hahn has joined the Cornell coaching staff, the team has won a record breaking seven consecutive EIWA Titles and increased its national presence by an elite level of success at the NCAA's most competitive tournaments. Over the past five years, Hahn has served as the personal coach for NCAA Champions. Steve Bosak and Cam Simaz, who both serve as clinicians. Through the Big Red Champs Clinic, Hahn will effectively teach the same techniques that have catapulted his and his wrestlers' successful careers.



Steve Bosak

- 2012 NCAA Champion
- 3X All-American

Steve is one of the most successful wrestlers to ever wear a Big Red singlet. Steve graduated from Cornell this spring, but leaves a tremendous legacy as a 2012 National Champion and a 3X All-American in the 184 pound weight class. In addition to these outstanding accomplishments, Steve closed out his career with 39 pins, (4th place all time in the Cornell record books), 74 bonus wins (6th all-time), and 131wins (7th all time). Steve was a two-time team captain, with him and Kyle Dake being named the first junior captains in the program's history. Steve is a two-time Pennsylvania state runner-up and 3x place winner from State College Area High School. Steve is looking forward to continuing his wrestling career by mentoring the next generation of champions.



Cam Simaz

- 2012 NCAA Champion
- 4X All-American

Cam Simaz is one of Cornell's most distinguished wrestlers of all time. Cam graduated last year as 2012 National Champion, a 4X All-American at the 197 pound weight class, and won countless tournament titles throughout his career. Cam capped off his senior season as the only Cornell wrestler to ever obtain 100 bonus wins. In addition to these outstanding accomplishments, Cam also finished his career with 145 wins (2nd place all time in the Cornell record books). 47 falls (2nd all-time) and served as a team captain with Steve and Kyle Dake. In high school, Cam was a 3X Michigan State Champion- making him one of the most legendary wrestlers to ever emerge from the state of Michigan. Fittingly, Cam was inducted into the Michigan Wrestling Hall of Fame this past year. At University Nationals this spring, Cam placed second at 84 kg. Cam currently resides in Ithaca, N.Y. and serves as a coach for the Finger Lakes Wrestling Club.
