Purpose of the Camp

The purpose of this camp is to expose central Ohio athletes to other colleges and universities that have wrestling programs located in Ohio. Many of these schools are not in central Ohio, and are looking to expand recruiting into the central Ohio area. This camp also helps coaches find those kids that might be that “diamond in the rough” that might not have the exposure needed to be know on the college level.

Common Questions

Who is this camp open to?

This camp is open to incoming eighth graders and all high school athletes including 2013 graduates. Smaller younger athletes are encouraged to bring a partner.

What should I expect?

This camp is a commuter camp. There will be 10 sessions lasting between one to two hours long. Each session will have a representative from an Ohio College or University. There will be thirty minute breaks between sessions to allow for restrooms, changing clothes, or eating. Showers and lockers will be provided. It is highly recommended to bring a change of clothes .

How Does this benefit my Athlete?

Not only will the exposure be helpful but there will be sessions that will offer technique that can be used for all three positions neutral, top or bottom. The campers will have the opportunity to pick and choose the sessions they want to attend, allowing them to build a camp that is individually tailored to their development and hopefully making for a very enjoyable and useful camp experience.
